Athletic Program
Academic Eligibility Policy (10/05/2015)

To participate in sports, students must maintain a C average in each major subject and have an A or B in conduct. **Students who are absent from school shall NOT be allowed to participate in practice or play in a game on the day they are absent.**

Items a-c represent the amendments to the athletic policy, which was adopted effective 12/01/2015:

a. Grades will be evaluated by the administration throughout the season on RENWEB, beginning two weeks prior to the first game and every two weeks after that. If a student's grades are below the minimums listed above, he/she will be placed on probationary status. The administration will notify the Athletic Director and the Athletic Director will relay the information to the head coach(es).

i. The probationary period will become effective the day after eligibility is determined and last for two weeks. During this time, a player is eligible to participate in practice sessions, but will **NOT** be eligible to participate in any games.

ii. At the end of the two week period, if the student's grades are above the minimum required for participation, he/she will be restored to full participation status.

iii. Students failing to achieve the minimum required academic standards at the end of the two week probation will be ineligible for any participation in athletic events for the remainder of the athletic seasons in progress. However, students may participate in the next athletic season, provided they meet the academic requirements prior to the team's selection. (i.e. tryouts for baseball or softball)

Example: A male student is listed on the football and basketball roster and is placed on probation after the first progress reports are released. At the end of the two week probation period, if his grades do not meet the minimum standards, he will be dismissed from **BOTH** the football and basketball teams. (...This student may be eligible to play on the baseball team, provided he meets the eligibility standards at the time of the tryout).

b. A student who receives an F in conduct OR who is involved in any event at school resulting in disciplinary action by the administration will be dismissed from any teams in which he/she is currently participating.

c. There will be **NO** refund of the registration fees for any student who is dismissed from the team due to academic or disciplinary reasons. The uniform deposit will be returned once the complete uniform and equipment have been returned to the school.
