Taylor Saddle Club is a series of day camps offered throughout summer at Taylor Estate Ranch. Students meet kind and patient horses; but more importantly, they learn to safely handle and ride them! In our new state-of-the art facility, students are protected from the harsh heat and unpredictable rain in our covered arena. Our instructors are knowledgeable and patient, and our counselors are helpful and fun! Students bring home a photo frame, art projects, camp t-shirt, and memories to last a lifetime! Classes are broken into two age groups. Our classes end at mid-day because, well – it's hot outside!

But my child has never ridden a horse...

Great! Then we don't have bad habits to break. Our classes are designed for students without previous horse experience. Even if your student has horse experience, we bet he or she will learn something new or build new skills. If your student does have experience and it's negative, we do need to know before class.

How do I register?

Send the application to the address listed with \$100 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit. Balance is due two weeks before camp begins. If you need to reschedule, you must do so before the two week deadline; however, you may move your deposit to another session or exchange for a Taylor Estate Ranch gift certificate (we also offer lessons and birthday parties), but you will not receive a cash or check refund.

When can I register?

NOW! Enrollment closes two weeks before camp begins. For example, if you enroll in camp May 29, your balance is due May 15. Please register early, classes fill quickly.
